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<p>General Comments</p> <p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the morning.</p> <p>K- One Room- The children were observed in the computer room using the computers upon arrival. The children were later observed transitioning indoors from outdoor play. Once in their classroom, they were observed eating lunch while their educator read a story and asked open ended questions. Additionally, handwashing was observed before eating lunch.</p> <p>Planetarium Room- The children were observed outdoors using the stationary equipment. After transitioning indoors, the children were engaged in a variety of activities, including building with LEGO, playing with Barbies, and participating in dramatic play by acting like dragons. Additionally, several children were observed eating snack, with handwashing occurring beforehand. The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in the dance mat, soccer, sliding, playing the kazoo, and using mini figurines with the dollhouses.</p> <p>½ Gymnasium – This space was not required today due to low attendance.</p> <p>Educators demonstrated positive interactions by using encouraging language and gentle reminders. They asked open-ended questions, listened actively, and extended children's ideas through conversations.</p> <p>All classrooms were putting together the final additions for their class festival movie. Educators shared that they will be taking the children to the BMO Studio Theatre tomorrow to watch each class's movie. Each classroom acts out their movie, which is recorded and then played at the theatre.</p> <p>Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility including photographs, and individual and collaborative artwork.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed on site included incident logs, daily attendance records, 7 staff files, five randomly selected children's files, monthly emergency evacuation, and fire drills.</p>
