<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including open-ended art, dramatic play, and outdoor play. The infants were observed exploring their outdoor play area. The preschool children were observed digging, dumping and looking for bugs. One educator was observed reading a story about bees with a small group of children outdoors.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments that support the children's current interests (books, monsters, bugs, worms, food and climbing). The Twos group have been working on an ongoing literacy project about the book "Orange Pear Apple Bear"; each child took a copy of the book and watercolour paints home to share with their families. The children created paintings, read the book and discussed the story with their families. The parents then wrote about their experience and sent in photos to share. Documentation in the Preschool Room showed how the children started a discussion at lunch about pickles - one child asked how they were made and their educator planned a pickle making day for them. They went to the local grocery store to buy the ingredients and worked together to make the pickles and then taste tested them. Photos and documentation of these experiences were displayed at the children's level for them to revisit.</p> <p>In response to the recommendations noted at the last Monitoring Inspection, art materials have been replenished within the Twos Room and the materials in the Preschool Room have been organized within each interest center, however the dramatic play materials are in need of organization. Recommend adding a costume rack or hooks to help keep the costumes from piling up on the floor.</p> <p>The Pack and Play mattress within the Infant Room is becoming stained, cover to be added or mattress to be replaced.</p> <p>During transitions, educators were observed conducting frequent headcounts to ensure that all children were present and accounted for.</p>
