General Comments Lovely variety of styles of documentation within the two preschool age group rooms. Props and materials are available for the children in the learning centers to support their current interests. Invitations for play are set up throughout the rooms and very creative! The children in both rooms were observed to be actively engaged in

activity and conversation with one another. The educators were attentive to the children's needs and consistently displayed kind interactions. A balance of indoor and outdoor play was observed.

The after school room has a variety of activities that are developmentally appropriate for the age group. A web of ideas has been created this fall. Recommending to enhance documentation as evidence of purposeful program planning based on the interests of the children.
