Monitoring Inspection - COVID-19 Recovery Phase

COVID-19 public health documents are being maintained as required. Observed the screening process and handwashing during monitoring inspection. A cleaning routine is established for toys, materials, high touch surfaces and bathrooms.

Recommending maintaining a visitor log to document name of essential visitor, purpose of visit, confirmed screening and temperature check, time in and time out.

Be sure that staff covering breaks are being added to the daily group log, including time in and time out.

Ensure that staff temperature reading is documented upon arrival and mid-day.

The children were observed engaging in play with their peers within the interest centers. During the morning
