General Comments

Educators were observed to engage with the children in a positive way in each bubble group. The children were happily playing with toys and materials in the interest centers and freely circulating their learning environments. Educators were very responsive to the children's needs and interacted with the children at their level. Topics of interest are being explored and evidence of the children's learning is visible. Each room has a binder that is being maintained with documentation and connections are being made to the NB Curriculum Framework.

Observed frequent handwashing, well-established routines for meeting COVID-19 protocols, and a balance of indoor and outdoor play.
