General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred this morning, July 4, 2024.

Children were observed during indoor and outdoor free play, snack time, and lunchtime. Proper handwashing was observed during the transition from snack to indoor free play. Steps or platforms are provided to allow children to reach regular-sized toilets or sinks.

Educators stated that the children are presently very interested in sensory play, including sand exploration both indoors and outdoors, picnics outdoors, and building forts with new play cushions. Outdoors, educators are playing an active role in the children's activities.

Parents are advised of incidents, and incident report forms are completed in the event of reportable incidents. Parents of children present at the center are granted entry at any time. Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of children receiving services are in attendance, weather permitting. Snacks are provided at least every three hours, and meals are served at recognized meal periods. The daily routine is posted in each room. Life-threatening allergies are posted. Defined learning/play areas were observed, and several pieces of the children's artwork were displayed throughout the facility. The sensory area is available, and sand/water, etc., is in sufficient quantity to play with. Accessories are provided and rotated. Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways are clean and free of clutter. Toxic products, such as chemical products and cleaners, are locked and inaccessible to the children. Drinking water is provided throughout the day.

General Comments

Opportunities are open for individual and group experiences. Portfolios are being completed with the children, and children have access to them. Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility.
