General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 8, 2025.

The children were observed actively engaging in both indoor and outdoor environments. Indoor activities included water play, exploration with green magnetic sand, reading books, playing with toy cars, and transitioning to outdoor play.

Outdoors, the children were seen digging in the sand, interacting with loose parts, and participating in open-ended art activities. Drinking water was always readily available and accessible.

All rooms were arranged with materials that encouraged exploration and play. Clearly defined learning and play areas were present, and children's artwork was prominently displayed throughout the facility.

General Comments

Documentation was visible and included class and individual portfolios, learning stories, and learning webs.

Toxic products, such as chemical cleaners, were securely locked and inaccessible to children.

A designated area was clearly marked for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included daily attendance records and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the administrator about the following:

- Ensuring that no algae is present on outdoor play equipment.
- Ensuring to complete the "Return After Exclusion" form upon a child's return to the facility
