Monitoring Inspection PreK and Afterschool Program: Children were observed engaged in a variety of activities such as pretend play with farm animals and trains, soccer, Lego, board games, outdoor play and open-ended art this morning/afternoon. The educators indicated the children are interested in painting, reading, Minecraft, Dogman, art and the sensory play. A monthly fire drill was conducted with licensing in attendance. All children and staff evacuated to a meeting place at the far end of the parking lot. Educators were observed taking attendance and a head count before re-
