Staff must purposefully plan for transition times to reduce behaviour challenges. (examples: use this time for trivia, singing, ice breakers, games, challenges, stories, etc)

## Senior Group:

Senior children arrived after school to an environment that was not set-up. This area must be set-up in a way that is inviting and interesting. Examples of invitations to be set-up, but not limited to: challenges, science experiments, sensory experiences, board games, loose parts, open-ended art materials, etc.

## General Comments

Trail mix was served at snack today. Trail mix must be served with another item (fresh fruit, vegetables, cheese, etc.) as this is not enough for children this age.
