General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including Lego, open-ended art, dramatic play, exploring magnet tiles and outdoor play. Each environment is set-up with a variety of materials and invitations for children to explore freely. QA Monitor discussed with staff displaying documentation throughout the environments. Example: photos, questions, quotes, webs, learning stories, ongoing projects, etc.

QA Monitor discussed the surfacing under the playground, as it is pooling away from the fall zones under the equipment. Ensure the surfacing is raked regularly. It was also, noted that cars drive around the back of the

school during outdoor play and park in the no parking zone, creating a difficult line of sight for crossing safely ensure more safety cones are added to the area where children cross the driveway. Ensure there is increased supervision in this area when children are crossing.

Written evacuation plan to be added to the floor plan drawing at the back door.

Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.

New staff file (4) review was completed during inspection; many documents were missing from files requiring staff to have to contact other sites to gather information. QA Monitor was able to verify the criminal records and SD checks; however, these documents must be in files on site.
