There were no invitations set up for the children's arrival on side 1. Some progress was noted on side 2 in displaying the children's interests (ex: Lego constructions are being displayed on a shelf within the creative art center), however, more needs to be added to both environments. Comments:	Indoor play space was noted to be full of clutter on the day of inspection. Items to be removed that are currently being stored within the indoor play area environment include: doll house in poor repair, hockey nets, TV, TV stand piled with garbage can lid and extension cords(located within the entrance of washroom), towels (used for cleaning) draped over bathroom stalls. There is also clutter (ex: vacuum, book bags, clothing, toys, games, containers) piled on top of the grey chair in the corner by the closet. This is not valuing the children's environment. Clutter must be removed immediately and the indoor play area is to be kept organized and set up in an inviting way.						
	Storage is required for washroom supplies. Cardboard box containing washroom supplies was observed being stored under the sink within the side 1 washrooms.						
	Windows and window ledges were noted to be unclean during today's inspection. If children are spending time sitting on the window sills, this should be incorporated into daily cleaning/sanitizing schedule. Requires immediate attention.						
	Repairs required: Electrical tape to be removed from black rubber baseboard along wall (side 1). This black rubber baseboard along wall (side 1). This black rubber baseboard along wall (side 1). This black rubber baseboard are to be replaced in many different areas, as it is breaking away from the walls (especially near corner are center and cozy area of side 2). The corners of the window sills located near the exit door are also in condition and need to be repaired and repainted. Both orange and white walls are in need of painting. Walls around doorway at the top of the stairs is in need of painting (previous comply by date of Feb.22, 2 and March 24, 2021). If this work can not be completed by May 7, 2021, supervisor must submit a date to inspector detailing we this work will be completed.

Comments:	Improvements were noted within creative art center on both sides. Additional collage materials are required on side 1. Ensure these are replenished regularly (Previous comply by date of Feb.15, 2021).						
	Books are depleted within both areas. Additional books to be added that are related to the children's interests and displayed in an inviting way.						
	There are some options for dramatic play (pop up animal/vet tent) but this is lacking in props and materials to support this interest.						
	Additional dramatic play materials are required within both environments. These should be tailored to the children's interests. Some kitchen related materials, pretend food accessories are accessible, but not capturing the children's interests. Refer to last monitoring inspection, dated March 18, 2021 for items that can be added.

	Grey chair remains to be in poor condition and has been moved into corner within side 1. (previously advise to be removed or repaired Nov. 9,2021, Feb. 15, 2021 and March 26, 2021).				
	Bean bag chair was unclean and dusty. No evidence that this can be removed or is being laundered regularly. A cover needs to be purchased that will be laundered or bean bag chair removed (Previous comp by date of Feb.15, 2021 and March 26, 2021).				
	Hooks beside storage closet accumulating dust and remain unclean (previously noted on March 26, 2021).				
	Outdoor play equipment: Toy trucks being stored indoors by cubbies were visibly soiled with dirt. Not evider that these are being cleaned. Educators to reference Appendix C cleaning chart within COVID-19 Guidance document for cleaning requirements (as previously advised within monitoring inspection on March 18, 2021				

Hand washing routines were observed today. The children were observed during indoor and outdoor play this afternoon.

The children were greeted by the educators and ate snack upon arrival today.

Some children were observed walking around with their snack, or eating on the window sill and putting food down on this surface. This can not happen and children should be provided with napkins/plates, etc.

Improvements were noted on both sides with respect to creative art centers. Recommended adding more loose parts/collage materials to side 1, and ensuring this is replenished and set up/organized daily for the children. Setting out a variety off these materials on the table for the children will also encourage open ended art to occur. There is an easel on side 1 as well but it is in need of storage for paint/water/accessories and should be set up and ready for the children. These items were piled on the floor under the easel during today's inspection.

Side 2 had paint, water, paper and brushes set up for the children's arrival today and the children were drawn to this immediately upon arrival. Some of the children's recent Lego creations are also being displayed on a shelf mounted to the wall on side 2 as well. This is a great way to highlight the children's interests and creations.

The hockey nets were noted to still be inside within the indoor play space at children's arrival. This has been discussed during past inspections, most recently on March 18, 2021. Program preparation (moving the hockey nets and outdoor materials outside, setting up invitations for the children) must be happening prior to the children's arrival.

Discussed removing items causing clutter within the indoor play area with supervisor and a need to devise a plan to remove these items promptly.

Additional materials are still required within the indoor play area that support the children's interests. Supervisor states that additional books, rugs, materials have been ordered but have not yet arrived.

A request for exemption is required for regulation 24(1) to maintain financial records at the regional YMCA rather than this site.
