General Comments

Improvements have been noted today. Environments have been rearranged and materials are now being displayed on shelving in a way that is inviting. Dramatic play materials, books and rugs have been added to the environments. The space seems to be flowing better and is more inviting.

Discussed with educators adding more materials that support the children's current interests; for example the children on one side are interested in painting, however today it was observed that there was no evidence of this interest through invitations, photos, documentation or materials. How can you support this interest? What new ways can you provide opportunities for painting?

The environment is freshly painted and the floors have been professionally deep cleaned. All clutter has been removed from the play areas and the hockey nets were set up outside.

Today it was observed that an educator was blowing a whistle to get the children's attention; this is not an example of valuing children. Educators must speak to the children in a way that respects and values them. Discussed with supervisor that the whistle is only to be used in emergency situations.
