General Comments							

Follow up to renewal inspection was completed today. Some orders for compliance have been fixed, but some remain.

General Comments

The children were observed during indoor and outdoor play.

There is a new cleaning/sanitization schedule in place for the washroom being shared by multiple groupings. Educators advised that this is being cleaned/sanitized between groupings and cleaning schedule chart was reviewed. Educators also stated that the washroom located out in the hallway is also used when needed to reduce wait times. Soap dispensers must be accessible at all times for the children in the washrooms. If educators are concerned about excessive waste of the hand soap, more supervision is required. One of the rooms (3/4s and 4/5s room) has been rearranged in an effort to ensure separation between groupings. There was only one group of children within the room during today's inspection as the other group was outdoors. If double sided shelving is being used, educators must ensure that materials that can be accessed on either side (ex: art bins within the easel shelving area) are being cleaned/sanitized between groupings.

Outdoor play area was also inspected today as it was snow/ice covered at the time of the renewal inspection. Supervisor on site was advised that garbage, food wrappers and debris was collecting inside tires and within other areas of the children's outdoor play space. This was removed immediately. Recommending that facility implements an outdoor checklist to specifically monitor the outdoor play area to ensure it is clean for the children going forward.

Another follow up inspection is required to ensure compliance.
