<p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Fours Room:</p> <p>Children engaged in variety activities this afternoon including; reading, open ended art, sensory play, building with Lego and puppet play. The room is set up with a variety materials that support the children's current interests in insects, insect habitats and the outdoors. Dramatic play materials; a beehive, a bee keeper costume and nets have been added to the dramatic play area to expand on current interests. Documentation is posted throughout the environment that includes; learning stories, photos, open ended drawings, children's words and questions, polls and examples of the children's mark making/printing.</p> <p>Three/Four Room:</p> <p>Children and educators observed in a variety of activities today including; mark making, open ended art, outdoor play and transitions. A variety of interests are evident throughout the environment. Educators have added materials and documentation to support the multiple interests in this group (nature, bugs, dinosaurs and beavers).</p> <p>Educator observed greeting a parent at departure time and discussing the child's day.</p> <p>Hand washing routines observed. Meatballs, mashed potatoes and peas served at lunch.</p>
