## **General Comments**

A renewal inspection occurred today. The children were observed indoors and outdoors. The educators engaged with the children on their level. The educators listened carefully to each child' needs and gave them time to express what they are feeling. The daily routine posted in each room was flexible yet predictable and supports opportunities for authentic learning (problem solving, creative thinking, relationship building, persistence).

Room#4 had lots of art making materials and Mutiple forms of documentation that demonstrates children's ongoing group project work and individual work in progress. The materials were organized so the children can help support the maintenance and care of materials being used.

The dramatic play area was open ended and set up as a "doctor office/operating table". The area provided multiple choices, solutions and possibilities for exploration and investigation. The children were pretending to be a doctor, using familiar real-life materials.

Room #5 Had multiple open-ended inviting learning areas. The children were observed playing with the ice cream maker and added other materials that were reinvented to use with it. The center is reflective of children's currant interests, curiosities and passions.

The children were observed playing at a "reception area" that consisted of and old computer and large calculator that promoted real life like experiences that they created.

All checks were completed. Cleaning supplies were locked and safe. Staff and children files were all observed and complete.
