It was determined during the inspection that this is the second outbreak in the last three months that has been declared by Public Health. <p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning/afternoon including open-ended art, outdoor play, dramatic play, and fine motor activities. A small group of children in the Three/Four Room were observed playing family in the dramatic play area, the children were pretending one of their peers was their baby. The children in the Fours Room spent the morning exploring the outdoor play area.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments to support the children's current interests (vehicles, family, and insects). The dramatic play area in the Fours Room has been transformed into an Insect Science Lab.</p> <p>Chicken strips with sweet and sour sauce, rice and vegetables were served for lunch. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.</p>

New staff file (6) review was completed. Ensure administrator's ECE certificate is added to staff file. Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (4/4) requirement.
