General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Photos of children and children's art displayed in each room.

Children engaged in play both indoors and outdoors today.

Hand washing routines observed this afternoon.

Discussed with educators ways to support children's interests within their environment through materials, books, invitations and documentation.

Environments must be set up for the children in a way that is inviting and engaging. Displaying materials neatly on shelving, tables and ledges creates an inviting environment for children to explore. Adding labels to bins encourages children to tidy materials independently and enhances literacy within their environment.
