Dramatic play props and materials to be added that are interesting and respond to the children's interests. Discussed creating prop boxes with supervisor. This will allow educators to rotate materials and respond to the children's interests. Room 3: Art materials depleted. Open ended art materials to be replenished daily/throughout the day. Paints accessible, no paint brushes. Ensure materials have accessories accessible to children. Examples toolbox with tools, paints with paintbrushes. See Appendix 24 - Materials and Equipment for School-Age Children in the Operator Manual for ideas of materials to add.
