Children observed engaged in fort building, art, clay sculpting and water play this afternoon.

Hand washing routines were observed today.

Discussed the importance of daily cleaning and sanitizing of materials, equipment and frequently touched surfaces to help prevent the spread of COVD-19. This has been an ongoing concern at this site during the last three monitoring visits. Needs immediate attention.
