Comments: Room 2: Floor unclean - accumulating dirt, broken pieces of toys and debris in corners, under heater and shelving. To be swept and mopped. Storage shelf by sink cluttered. Extra materials scattered on floor. To be organized.

Comments: Room 2: Art materials depleted. A variety of open-ended art materials must be accessible to the children. Art materials to be replenished daily. Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to: variety of paper in colours, textures and sizes, paint, paint brushes, paint rollers, mark making materials, glue, tape, feathers, tissue paper, cardboard tubes, fabric, yarn, ribbon, recycled items, items collected from nature, collage materials, etc.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Jul 26, 2021	
Comments: Room 1: Tent floor accumulating dirt and debris. Cereal had been spilled throughout the tent and it was determined that it had been there since the day before. Food spills must be cleaned up promptly. Room 2: Art shelf and board game/book shelf cluttered and unorganized. To be decluttered and organized in a way the invites children to engage with materials. Three grey beanbag chairs unclean. To be cleaned or replaced. Recommend adding removable covers that can be laundered regularly.
