Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to flashlights, test tubes and beakers, prisms, mirrors, colour wheels, magnets, goggles, magnifying glasses, timers, measuring tapes, scale, plants, animals, items from nature, etc.  Materials that create an inviting environment for children lacking within this room. Examples of items to add, but not limited to plants, soft lighting, photos, documentation supporting current interests and experiences, challenges, art pieces, items from nature and age-appropriate books displayed throughout the room.  Materials that support the children's current interests lacking within the environments. This week the day camps are "Back to Nature" and "Y Games", items to be added to the environment that support this interest-based camp the children registered for.
