Educators have established a new plan for hand washing/washroom use to prevent the crossing of bubbles and report that this is working well. Each group has a designated sink/washroom to use and educators report that washrooms are being cleaned hourly.

Additional books could be added within particular groups to enrich literacy, particularly relating to the children's interests and displayed in a way to capture the children's attention.
