There was a doctor kit observed on a shelf but no other props or accessories to support this. What else are the children interested in? General Comments

Renewal inspection completed today.

The children were observed upon arrival after school, within their indoor play environment and during the process of an unplanned evacuation drill within the school. Staff members ensured that all children evacuated the facility. Staff members were observed performing head counts and referencing mandatory attendance records to account for all children.

Some documentation was posted within the indoor environment and demonstrated interests in creative art, science experiments, growing plants, and cars.

There were some materials set out on some of the tables as an invitation for the children's to explore, but Page 2 of 3

purposeful planning was not evident across all environments. Ensure that the children's interests are being documented and that program planning involves adding materials/props to support these interests. Hand washing and snack time routines were observed at time of inspection.
