Utensil drawer - accumulating dirt and debris. Drawer and utensils to be cleaned and sanitized. Discussed with educators and supervisor; these items must not be used until thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. Counter tops - unclean. To be cleaned regularly. Immediate attention required.</p> <p>Mini gym door - paint peeling. To be painted.</p> <p>Senior Room: Shelving removed, exposing damaged tiles. To be repaired.</p>

Examples of items to add, but not limited to costumes, hats, scarves, purses, office supplies, restaurant items, clipboards, cash register, money, pretend food, real life items, loose parts, tools, items that support the children's interests.</p>

Random review of staff files - all paperwork complete.</p> <p>Ensure emergency contacts within child files are local (within an hour of facility). Ensure incident log dates include the year.</p> <p>Inspector to be updated on Parent Board.</p>
