Comments: A few children's bottles in the 2 year old room were not labelled. All personal items must be labelled with the child's name. Names were placed on the bottles on site. Deficiency is now compliant			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe the children play outside in the rain. The children were given opportunities to explore their outdoor play area by jumping in puddles, playing with mud and with the water. These opportunities for exploration and learning were nurtured by the educators.</p> <p>During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor and the administrator discussed the Inclusion Support Program and the ways that the facility is providing additional support to children who need the additional support.
