Comments: During the renewal inspection, it was observed that one educator's first aid and CPR certificate had expired. As per licensing requirements, all administrators and educators must hold a valid first aid and CPR certificate. The administrator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that the educator is enrolled in a certification course scheduled for July 4. Once completed, the updated certificate must be submitted to the Quality Assurance Monitor via email.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor reviewed 12 child profiles and found that 4 of them were missing the medical practitioner's information. Each child's record must include the name, telephone number, and address of their medical practitioner. The operator must ensure that all child record files are complete prior to enrollment.			
25 An operator of a licensed facility shall post in a clearly visible and prominent place on the premises: (f) the name and telephone number of the members of the board of directors, if applicable.	25(f)	Jul 04, 2025	Jul 04, 2025
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the telephone numbers for the board of directors were missing from the posted list. As per regulations, the names and phone numbers of all board members must be displayed in a visible and prominent location within the facility. Upon being informed, the administrator took immediate action and updated the list to include the missing phone numbers. Deficiency is now compliant			
41(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall (a) post diaper-changing procedures in diaper-changing areas.	41(3)(a)	Jul 04, 2025	Jul 04, 2025
Comments: During the renewal inspection, it was noted that in one of the diaper changing areas, the diaper changing procedures were not posted. As required, the diaper changing procedures must be displayed in a visible location within all diaper changing areas. The administrator immediately addressed the issue by printing a new copy and posting it in the appropriate location. Deficiency is now compliant
