Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the monthly review and maintenance plan on all stationary equipment had not been completed for the month of October, November and December. The monthly review and maintenance plan must be completed on all stationary equipment. The administrator shared that the staff member's review and conduct maintenance of the outdoor play area before each use in the morning and the afternoon. The administrator immediately added the missing information. Deficiency is now compliant								
39(3) Despite paragraph (2)(b), medications administered in cases of anaphylactic shock shall not be stored in a locked space.	39(3)	May 08, 2025	May 08, 2025					
Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that an EpiPen in a classroom that was not easily accessible, as it was stored in a locked box with a code. Medications used for anaphylactic shock must be stored safely but easily accessible. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the staff member regarding the EpiPen that must be easily accessible, the staff member immediately stored the EpiPen easily accessible, out of reach of the children. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the renewal inspection, The Quality Assurance Monitor observed 3 water bottles that were not labelled with the name of the child in one classroom. Personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. The staff member immediately labelled the 3 water bottles with the name of the child. Deficiency is now compliant

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for the renewal inspection. During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor is present during snack time, indoor play, lunch, nap time and outdoor play. During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed 1 expired medication in two classrooms stored in the locked medication box. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the staff members that all expired medication should be returned to the parents, and that new medication should be requested if								
needed.
