Comments: 4 out of 7 child's file has incomplete emergency contacts. Child's file needs to contain at least 2 emergency contacts with full address and phone number.

Comments: A Clorox bottle was left on the high shelf in the bathroom. Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies needs to be locked. Educator locked the Clorox bottle in the storage room. Deficiency is now compliant.			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Apr 27, 2022	
Comments: Several water bottles were not labeled. Water bottles need to be identified with the child's name. Inspector had a discussion with the administrator to remind parents to label water bottles.
