<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) conducted an on-site monitoring inspection. At the time of the visit, the following elements were reviewed and verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Incident records - Indoor play area - Outdoor play area - Required postings - Daily activities <p>During the visit, the QAM discussed recent changes to the Board of Directors (BOD) with the administrator. It was noted that the list of BOD members posted within the facility did not match the information currently on file in the licensing system. The administrator advised that changes to the Board of Directors were made in September.</p> <p>The QAM reminded the administrator that all changes to the Board of Directors must be completed through Service New Brunswick and that the Licensing Department must be notified through the submission of an Application for Change along with the required documentation.</p> <p>A copy of the Application for Change was provided to the administrator for completion. The completed application must be submitted to the QAM as soon as possible.</p> <p>During the inspection, children were observed participating in indoor play activities. The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) noted positive interactions between educators and children, including educators getting down to the children's level and actively engaging with them during play.</p>
