Comments: In one child record the name, address and telephone number of the child's medical practitioner were missing. This is a second reminder that all child records must contain the name, address and telephone number of the child's medical practitioner.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached,	24(1)(b)(iv)	Jul 04, 2024	
Comments: In one child record out of 12 verified, the address was not filled out for one of the emergency contacts. In one child record out of 12 verified, the address was not filled out completely for both emergency contacts. This is a second reminder that all child records must have the name, address and telephone number of at least 2 emergency contacts.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the children's cubbies were easily accessible and provided for their belongings. Deficiency is now compliant.

<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed waters all over the facility not labelled with the child's name. This is a second reminder that all personal belongings must be labelled with the child's name.</p>

<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that children's belonging was still scattered everywhere. This is a second reminder that children's belonging should be stored separately.</p>			
<p>40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (c) stored separately for each child.</p>	40(1)(c)	Jul 04, 2024	
<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that children's belonging was still scattered everywhere. This is a second reminder that children's belonging should be stored separately.</p>			
<p>48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.</p>	48(2)	Jul 04, 2024	
<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed some lunch boxes , lunch containers and food , scattered throughout the facility not labelled with the child's name. This is a second reminder that all food brought from home must be labelled with the child's name.</p>
