Comments: During the follow-up inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that all children personal belonging is labelled with the child's name. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed all food brought from home was labelled with the child's name. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a follow-up inspection. The child to staff ratio is maintained throughout the visit.

While on site the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children playing outdoors and some halloween activities.

A discussion between the administrator and Quality Assurance Monitor regarding a consent for outing was had. The Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that staff members were discussion choosing some children to go to a car dealership for a photo-op with the vehicle that was provided to the facility. The Quality Assurance Monitor questioned the staff member's in questions if the parents had signed a consent form for the outing. The operator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that each parent had signed a consent form for outings and transportation. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the operator that a consent stating where the children are going, with the date and time is needed when an outing occurs. The operator decided to cancel the outing.
