Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the daily attendance records of children were at the front door of the facility. The administrator informs the Quality Assurance monitor that parents can sign in and sign out their children. Attendance records are confidential and cannot be posted or viewed by parents. That being said, daily attendance records of children must only be completed by staff members. The administrator immediately brought the attendance sheet to the educators and will inform the parents that educators will sign in and sign out the children as they arrive and leave. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed an unlocked cabinet in the kitchen containing cleaning supplies and toxic products. Lysol wipes and Lysol aerosol spray were also found in a storage room upstairs, only locked with a latch. Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked in key and inaccessible to children. The administrator immediately locked the kitchen cabinet and moved the cleaning product out of that storage room. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. During the visit, the followings were verified: - Ratio and maximum number of children - If required documents are posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility - Administrative records maintained on-site - Storage space for toxic products, cleaning supplies and medication. At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children play indoors, and transitioned to the outdoors.
