Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that in one of the classrooms, only one child was signed in, although two were in attendance. The staff member must ensure that children's daily attendance records are completed promptly and accurately. The staff member immediately added the arrival time of the child. Deficiency is now compliant			
31(6) The outdoor play area of a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre at which services are provided to infants or preschool children shall be enclosed with a fence at least 1.22 m in height with a gate that is secured at all times when the children are present.	31(6)	Oct 31, 2025	
Comments: The infant play area is currently enclosed by a gated fence that does not meet the required height of 1.22 meters. As per regulations, the outdoor play areas for infants and preschoolers must be securely enclosed by a fence that is at least 1.22 meters high. This standard is in place to help prevent young children from leaving the play area unsupervised. The administrator advised the Quality Assurance Monitor (via email) that the fence is scheduled to be replaced in October. The fence must be replaced before October 31st. This will be verified during a monitoring inspection.

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator confirmed that the Quality Improvement Plan (QIP) is current, and all eligible educators are actively completing their required 10 hours of professional learning per renewal year.

During the Monitoring Inspection, educators were observed engaging in positive interactions with the children, including singing and dancing. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed smooth transitions between activities: from morning snack to bathroom routines, followed by free play and then outdoor play.
