The staff member must ensure that children's daily attendance records are completed promptly and accurately. The staff member immediately added the arrival time of the child. Comments: The infant play area is currently enclosed by a gated fence that does not meet the required height of 1.22 meters. As per regulations, the outdoor play areas for infants and preschoolers must be securely enclosed by a fence that is at least 1.22 meters high. This standard is in place to help prevent young children from leaving the play area unsupervised.

The fence must be replaced before October 31rst. This will be verified during a monitoring inspection.
