Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that one staff member has an ECE course from a college that is not recognized for licensing requirements (after referring to appendix 25 of the operator's manual). The operator must contact the Training Recognition and Exemption Department to verify if the ECE is recognized/exempt. If not, the staff member must be enrolled in the Introduction to ECE course. The proof that the ECE is recognized/exempt or the proof of enrollment in the Introduction to ECE course if needed of the staff member in question may be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor via email once received.

Each staff member must have obtained a criminal records check and the vulnerable sector check prior to employment. The staff member in question was not on site during the renewal inspection and was contacted to obtain a criminal records check before coming on site. The staff member in question must obtain a criminal records check before being permitted on site.
