Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor noted that the storage area containing cleaning supplies was closed but not locked. Toxic products, chemical products, and cleaning supplies must be stored in a locked location. Upon notification by the Quality Assurance Monitor, the kitchen staff immediately locked the storage area. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed an educator place a hot coffee in the outdoor play area where it was easily accessible to children. The hot beverage was not in a spill-proof container. Hot beverages must be kept in spill-proof containers. Upon notification by the Quality Assurance Monitor, the educator immediately disposed of the coffee. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed an educator place a hot coffee in the outdoor play area where it was easily accessible to children. Hot beverage containers must be kept out of reach of infants and children up to and including two years of age. At the time of the inspection, five two-year-old children were present in the outdoor play area. Upon notification by the Quality Assurance Monitor, the educator immediately disposed of the coffee. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site to conduct a monitoring inspection and was present during the morning. During the visit, the following elements were verified and discussed: - Child-to-staff ratios - Indoor play areas - Daily activities

General Comments

- Daily routine
- Storage of toxic products
- Storage of personal belongings
- Washrooms
- Diaper-changing areas
- Rest areas

During the inspection, the children played outdoors.

The Quality Assurance Monitor discussed the condition of the diaper-changing mats with the operator. The mats were beginning to show signs of wear and were starting to tear. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommended that the operator monitor their condition closely to ensure they do not tear further. To ensure proper cleaning and sanitization, diaper-changing mats must be maintained in good condition.

While visiting the classrooms to verify daily programming, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to confirm evidence of ongoing documentation through learning stories that were visibly displayed in all classrooms.
