Comments: During the inspection, the inspector observes that in 3 out of 4 classrooms, toxic products were stored in unlocked cupboards. The cleaning products identified included a bottle of Vim and a bottle of Goo Gone. The inspector informed the administrator that all toxic products must be locked under key. The administrator removed the products from all classrooms and ensured they were stored in a locked location. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments
The inspector is on site to conduct a renewal inspection. During the visit, both indoor and outdoor free play activities are observed. The inspector also observes the morning snack, lunch period, and nap time. In one classroom, a painting activity with the children is observed in the morning, along with free play in the gym. A discussion is held with the administrator regarding professional development hours to ensure that all employees complete the required 10 hours by November 30. Another discussion is held with the administrator regarding all children belonging must be labelled with the child's name. Another discussion addressed an employee whose Early Childhood Educator (ECE) certificate is not recognized under Appendix 25. This was previously identified during a monitoring visit by the Quality Assurance Monitor and communicated to the administrator. The administrator has since contacted the exemption team and is awaiting a response. If the exemption is denied, the employee must complete the 90 hour Introduction to ECE course. The ratio is maintained throughout the inspection.
