Comments: In one classroom, 22 children were present but only 17 were signed in on the attendance sheet. Using the attendance form provided by the department, the attendance records must be completed each time a child arrives and leaves and must be accurate and reflect all children present at any given time. Educators immediately signed in the children. Deficiency is now compliant			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Mar 18, 2024	
Comments: At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed inadequate supervision. She observed children wrestling with one another, hitting others with their hands, chasing children with objects and hitting others with toys. The QA Monitor also observed a child asking another child to stop. Risky play can be acceptable if the supervision is adequate. The child to staff ratio was respected, however the supervision was insufficient. The children must be adequately supervised to ensure the environment is safe and secure for children.			

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a Monitoring inspection.

During the inspection, these were verified:

- Child to staff ratio
- Daily activities
- Washrooms
- Child guidance

The daily program includes a variety of activities purposely planned according to the ages and development of the children.

There are sufficient and safe washroom facilities to meet the needs of the number and ages of children enrolled

General Comments

in the facility.

During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe indoor free play and the transition to outdoor play.

While verifying new staff member's files, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the detachment stamp or seal was unclear on one criminal record check/ vulnerable sector check. It is recommended to have a copy with a visible detachment stamp or seal so licensing staff can confirm if the criminal check\ vulnerable sector check is valid.
