Comments: Operator has begun using a planning tool since last inspection, she did document some materials that she offered to children however she did not demonstrate that she reflected on the children's interests, passions, strengths and abilities. For the Operator to maintain compliance with this Regulation, she must document a program in which she engages with the children and reflects on their interests, passions, strengths and abilities. To demonstrate that the program is purposeful, Operator must be able to show that she used the children's interests, passions, strengths and abilities to create her plans.

Comments: Some additional materials are out, however Operator must also ensure that children have access to an art area. Currently all art materials are stored in a cupboard. To maintain compliance with this Regulation, the Operator must offer art materials on a low, open, readily accessible shelf and refer to pages 60-62 of the Operator Manual for a complete list of the minimum requirements. Will be verified at the next monitoring inspection.			

General Comments
<p>Operator created some documentation of children's learning, however all of the documents were stuffed into a single binder as she sent the children's portfolios home. Operator will be creating new portfolios for each child, however it is recommended that she also create a space in the indoor environment to display documentary evidence of the children's learning (such as learning stories, photos, children's artifacts, etc...)</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor will send additional resources that the Operator may find helpful, and will return for a follow up monitoring inspection. The QAM will also reach out to the Curriculum consultant as the Operator's program planning, documentation and environment does not reflect the implementation and delivery of the NB Curriculum Framework. This is required in accordance with Section 4.2 of the Designation Agreement for New Brunswick Early Learning Homes.</p> <p>The Operator must contact the Curriculum Consultant before Thursday, July 22nd. The Operator must also contact the Quality Assurance Monitor if she requires additional guidance/support or information on how to maintain compliance of the Regulations.</p>
