Medications were found in a container under the sink in 3 classrooms. The cabinet was closed with a child safety clip. Inspector recommend switching to a locked					
system to ensure it is unaccessible to children.					
General Comments					
During the renewal inspection an educator informed herself about the transition period recommended for children when changing groups. Inspector refered her to read Section 8 Supervision and child guidance under page 55-59 of the Operator Manual for more information. Inspector also mentionned that it's important to keep ratios when transitioning children from one group to another and to remember that infants can't be mixed with any other group until they are 2 year old.					
Inspector had a discussion with the Adminitrator about her first aid certification. Administrator doesn't work with the children. Inspector advised the administrator that if she is to work in classrooms as a releif or emergency staff it is recommended she get her first aid certificat in the event something happened while she was in the classroom.					
Documentary evidence of the child's learning, purposely planned activites are visible in the classrooms. Children enjoyed the nice snow outdoors. Positive interactions were observed.
