The children and educators were observed following all COVID-19 guidelines in regards to mask wearing in common areas. The children and educators were also observed washing hands numerous time during the inspection.

The children's learning is visible throughout the learning environments in the form of webs, pictures, learning stories as well as personal portfolios for each child.

Recommending in the spring that additional pea gravel be added to the outside play areas under the fall zones: Slide area.

Positive interactions and meaningful conversations were observed between the educators and the children. The educators were observed down at the children's level in conversation as well as speaking respectfully to them. The children appeared happy and content in their environments and with their educators.
