This afterschool program uses the cafeteria as their space. The educator has a trolley with the items that are required. During snack, the educator placed out a number of invitations on the table and floor- a puzzle, lego, board games, books by the large rocking chairs, race track, blocks and coloring.

Children washed their hands before snack and the educator ensured she sanitized the cafeteria table. During snack, the educator sat with the children and started a conversation. Children discussed Halloween and the costumes they like. She encouraged them to take turns speaking and made sure each child had a chance to share.

Attendance records are up to date and being completed in full. Absence codes are being used appropriately.

When going outdoors to the school playground, the educator put up a sign in the door to notify parents/guardians where they were.

The educator used positive child guidance practices. She was patient, gave kind reminders and showed interest in the children's play. She strategically placed herself on the playground to provide supervision to the various spots where the children were playing.

While waiting for the older children to arrive, the educator started reading a Halloween themed chapter book with the children. She also completed a mad lib with the children. The children helped her think of nouns, adjectives, and verbs.
