General Comments

Children were engaged in free play this morning when licensing staff arrived. Having two educators with each group ensures child to staff ratio is met or exceeded at all times.

Invitations were set up for the children such as a container of playdough and resources. a selection of coloring sheets and markers, materials for beading, and a puzzle set out with the pieces face up inviting children to complete. Resources in both rooms are accessible and reflect curriculum areas. There is a selection of books on the bookshelves in each room. In one room, two children entered the tent and read a chapter book together.

Bulletin boards highlight children's creativity with colored sheets, created images, created books, and completion of comic strips. The children in one room have also added to the store area with intentional placement of the cash register, materials, food, and decorative items along with the hours the store is open and created open and close signs.

Educators were observed to be very respectful to children and encourage their independence. The educator in one room visited each group of children in the room to remind them of five minutes until clean-up time then the second educator quietly said, "If you hear me..." when the five minutes was up with children quickly responding and then cleaning up.

Children lined up to wash their hands and visit the washroom before snack and the educators changed the plan of eating snack outside today as children expressed, they were hungry and didn't want to wait for everyone to be ready to go outside. The educators followed the children's lead and also reminded the children that if anyone wanted to eat snack outside, they still could. After snack in the second room, children were invited to play bingo with one child having the opportunity to call out the numbers when they grew tired of playing.

Ensure there are enough chairs in each room for the number of children, educators, and any support staff so educators and children can sit together in play and meals.
