Comments: Staff attendance records are not being kept up to date. Staff must sign in and out each time they enter a room for work even if they are doing split shifts. Staff signed in at the time of my visit and the administrator advised that they will do this going forward.								

General Comments

Licensing staff arrived when educators were meeting the school age bus. Licensing staff observed children getting off the bus and walking back into the facility in an organized fashion. Educators advised licensing staff that frequent headcounts and attendance is taken. Licensing staff observed educators calling parents when children who were suppose to be at the facility did not arrive. Safety practices were in place and followed at the time of visit.

There is a variety of materials and learning centres set up for the children. The educators set up invitations for play including science experiments and art activities. Educators are building their activities based on the children's interest and documenting with pictures, learning stories and charts.

Licensing staff advised educators that the mixed spray bottles with approved solutions in them should be kept out of the reach of the children but not locked up. This is to ensure frequent use. Dish soap is not a toxic product and may be left out on the counter.
