General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a follow-up license renewal inspection on August 23rd, 2024.

While making observations in the outdoor learning environment, licensing staff observed invitations of play set up for the children. There was an art centre with a two-sided easel, chalk and white board, paint, paint brushes, paper, chalk, crayons, and bubbles. There was a block centre with various sized wooden blocks along with Duplo blocks. The mud kitchen had accessories such as mixing spoons, bowls, cups, measuring cups and cutlery. The sand box had multiple shovels, sifters and buckets.

Licensing staff also observed a cozy centre where a large mat was placed over the pea gravel along with pillows placed on the mat and a bucket of books for the children to read.

Licensing staff noted multiple gross motor materials placed in the outdoor environment such as a basketball net, balancing blocks and various sized balls for the children to engage in play with.

While observing and completing child-to-staff ratio, licensing staff noted that in each classroom, the ratios more than met regulation according to the Early Childhood Services Act.

Licensing staff is going to contact the district team, specifically an Early Learning Consultant for Curriculum, visit
