General Comments
<p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the children were getting up from nap time and preparing for snack time. Proper diaper changing procedures and hand washing was observed. The tables were cleaned in each classroom after snack time and floors were swept.</p> <p>In the 4/5 classroom the children were observed having circle time where they sat together and went over days of the week and the weather. Afterwards, they read "Fire Drills" and "Ducks in a Row". The Educator paused several times to ask the children questions about the story. In the 3/4 class the children were celebrating a birthday today. The children enjoyed a cupcake as part of the celebration. As they finished their snack, they sat and read a story with an Educator. In the 2's and Senior Infants room, the groups were having a dance party. The children were laughing and smiling as the danced with their peers and Educators.</p> <p>There have been several changes since the Renewal Inspection. It is recommended to add more documentation of learning the classrooms such as learning stories, webbing, pictures of the children engaged in activities. Attendance records, potential illness and incident reports are being completed and were observed in all the classrooms. The menu is posted in the classrooms and outside the kitchen area. Afternoon snack matches what was on the Menu for today. The Educators were engaged with the children and attentive to their needs throughout the visit.</p> <p>During today's visit, none of the classes went outside in the afternoon. As a reminder, it is stated in the Operator Manual The daily routine of a licensed facility shall include:(a) outdoor play for at least one hour in each four-hour bock of time when the majority of children</p>
