Administrative records were reviewed - attendance is being completed, fire drills and outdoor check list performed monthly including the first aid checklist. The staff record was also reviewed and all in order. The administrator advised that she will be finishing the micro-credentialing course. This is great news and congratulations. Upon arrival everyone had finished lunch and was enjoying some quiet time activities - painting, playing dominos and also many were interested in practicing magician tricks - card tricks. They were taking turns, playing cooperatively and having alot of fun trying to figure the trick. The administrator provided ample time for transitioning into the next activity. Everyone will be getting ready, cleaning up and going outside. It is snowing but warm. The afterschool group had other ideas and decided to eat snack before going outdoors. This demonstrates how the educator follows the children's lead. The indoor playspace is inviting, toys, equipment, and materials are age appropriate and accessible, and there is lots of variety and sufficient quantity of toys and materials to choose from. Lots of conversation and interaction observed between educator and school age group. The educator engages and asks questions and shows a genuine interest in the children.
