Comments:

Administrator stated that she has not had to use potential illness forms as there has not been a child who has had to leave the facility sick. They are aware that if a child becomes ill, they are to be separated and picked up within 1 hour of notification. The potential illness form would be filled out and signed by parent(s) upon pick up.

Filing system is meticulous and information regarding the regulations could be easily verified.

Each group has pre-planned programming. Educators stated that they adjust it based on the children's interests. Documentation of their learning is evident and children are able to describe what they at doing on a daily basis.

Incident logs and reportable incidents are being filled out as per legislation. Please keep log and reportable incidents separate.

This facility uses a municipal outdoor play space as their licensed space. Children play in two separate areas if both groups are outside at the same time. Administrator stated that space is inspected for areas of concern prior to using it and a monthly outdoor checklist is being filled out. Any and all problems are reported to the city. There were no evident issues at time of visit.

Toxic products are stored upstairs in a locked closet, as well as, downstairs underneath the kitchen sink. The safety devices currently used to keep children out of them are no longer approved by the Department. Toxic Products must be secured by lock and key. Administrator stated that she can lock kitchen door as she has a key to the door. Toxics were locked at time of visit.

The school age room without the air conditioner was very warm at time of early morning visit. To avoid any health issues for the children, it is recommended that a cooling system of some sort is used to provide a cooler

and healthier environment for the children.
