 When I arrived for the monitoring visit, the team leaders were on their way to get the children off the bus. Both leaders had on their yellow Boys and Girls Club safety vests and they brought their backpack with the necessary items for being outside of the centre. The Parent Information Board is well organized and has all the required postings. Children's hooks are labelled and there are two brightly colored benches for their shoes which is a nice added touch to this area. The snack today was nachos, salsa, cheese strings and oranges. Water was served as well. This was the correct snack according to the posted menu for March. Throughout my visit, the team leaders encouraged children to wash their hands numerous times and tables and washrooms were regularly sanitized. The daily programming is posted on the Parent Board and the leader also wrote it on the white board for the children to see. The programming was very well thought out and included group games, icebreakers, creative activities and outdoor time for each day. Detailed instructions and materials were also included in the programming which allowed for activities to be smoothly implemented. Both team leaders were thoroughly engaged with the children and listened to the children's stories about their school day. Team work was evident when snack was being prepared and the craft was being offered to the children. Six children were present and both leaders remained on site which allowed children to have lots of interaction and time with their leaders. When children required extra guidance or assistance, leaders were quick to act and managed behaviors with kindness and respect.
