General Comments							
Upon Licensing staff arrival, the first group of children were observed walking from school and arriving at the facility with Educators. The children changed their shoes and hung up their bookbags and coats on hooks with their names. The children then washed their hands and began to play. The indoor play space had ample amounts of board games, art supplies, magnet toys, plastic play animals, a water play station and books. Educators announced to the children that it was time to start cleaning up a bit before they had to leave to walk to meet the second group of children from school. The transition was smooth, and enough time was given for the children to tidy up and choose a toy to take with them on the walk. Once the second group arrived, the group prepared for snack in the upstairs room. An Educator was observed re-directing the room by saying "If you can hear me, clap once! If you can hear me, clap twice! The children were engaged and were eager to clap. During snack time, an Educator was observed playing a game called whip around with some children, where they answered questions such as favorite movie and favorite singer, while others played with their friends and coloured. The group ended their day outside on the playground playing before pick up. Indoor shoes were changed and backpacks were taken outside. Positive child guidance, kind words of encouragement and praise such as "good job my friend!" were observed and heard throughout the inspection. Child and staff files were in order with required documentation. Licensing staff recommends for renewal pending Fire.
